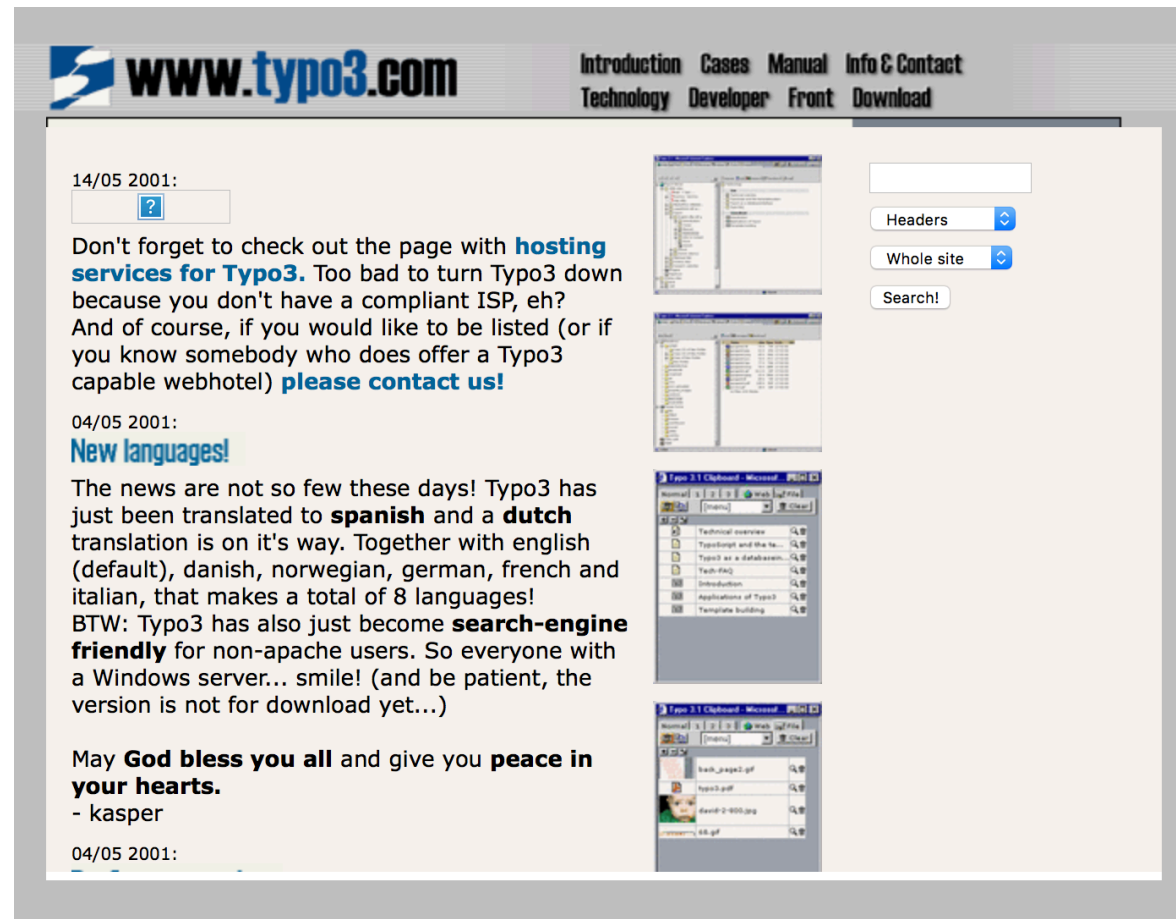

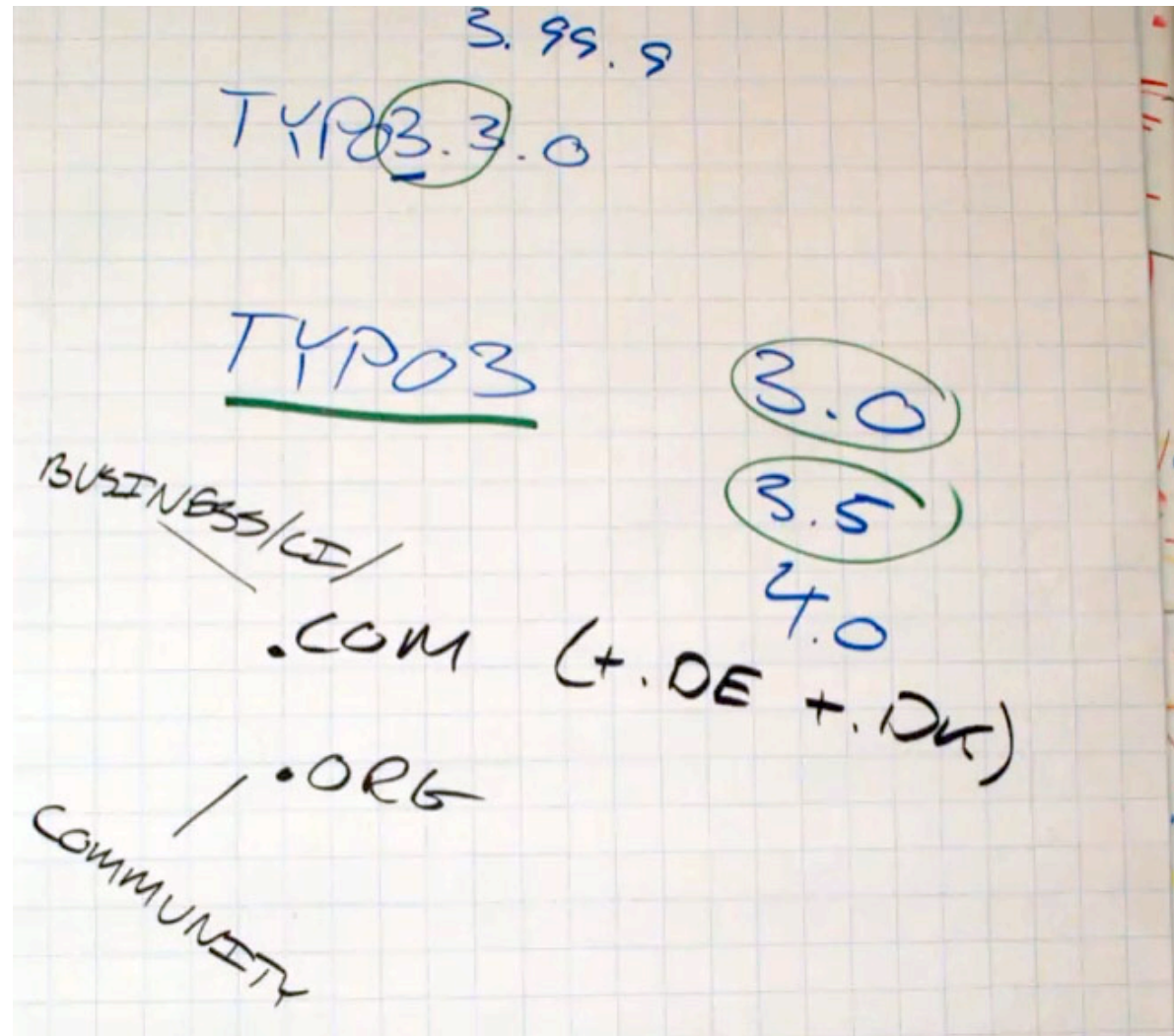

Why should you upgrade?

Things move forward. TYPO3 does too. The technology in this release has been stable for half a year now and if you are stuck with old 3.3 and 3.2 and who-knows-what, get on with it now.

Maybe another serious reason is that a number of security problems has been fixed. Some of these has been discovered by a Internet security company by request from a customer. They have made a report over the vulnerabilities of 3.5b5 (and earlier) and within one or two weeks they will make that report public. Version 3.5.0 contains fixes for these problems.

- New team leader Thomas Löffler



THE PRESENT



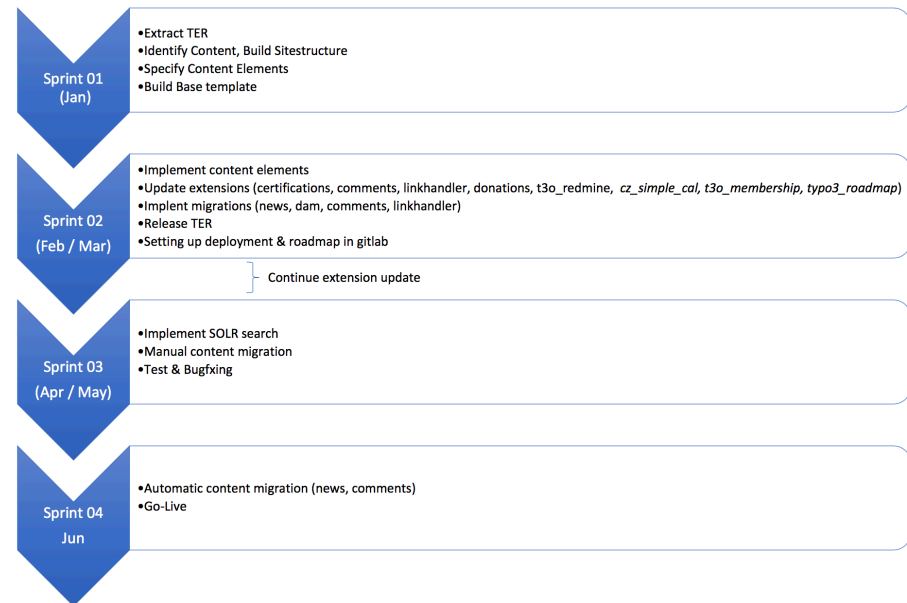
- First approach for a responsive update in 2015 failed
- Resources in 2015/2016 were focussed at typo3.com
- Start of conception in autumn 2016
- Design contest in december 2016



THE PRESENT



- First approach “launch only a startpage” – was declined by majority of stake holders
- New goal: Full relaunch in 2017
- But: No new content 😞 - due lack of resources



THE PRESENT - CHALLENGES



- Lacking of resources
- Changing bottlenecks
- Inter team communication was difficult
